

Burnham Market F.A.Q

When does Burnham Market take place?

Every Wednesday, with the exception of the last week in December and the first week in January.

What time does the market take place?

Set up is from 7am and traders usually start packing away around 3pm.

Are tables provided?

No, you will need to provide your own.

Are gazebos or covers provided?

No, you will need to provide your own.

What are the market rates?

The first week is deemed to be a trial week for both parties and will be free of charge. All further weeks will be charged at £10 per table (6ft in length).

Our winter rates January to March inclusive are reduced by 50% at £5 per table (6ft in length).

When will payment be collected?

Payment (cash only please) will be collected from you on the day of the market. You will be asked to sign a receipt and a copy will be given to you.

How do I apply for a stall?

What documents will I need to provide?

The following documents should be provided (so they can be photocopied) along with a completed application form.

- ◆ Proof of name (photo ID)
- ◆ Proof of address (utility bill)
- ◆ Copy of Public Liability Insurance
- ◆ Copy of Market Traders Licence
